

Minerals Technologies Names Thomas Stam To Head Construction Technologies Business Segment

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NEW YORK, August 24, 2016-Minerals Technologies Inc., (NYSE: MTX) announced today that it has named Thomas Stam Vice President, MTI & Managing Director of the Construction Technologies business segment. Mr. Stam, whose most recent position was Senior Vice President of Building Materials and Environment Products, within the Construction Technologies segment, will succeed Patrick Carpenter, who is leaving the company to pursue other interests.

Mr. Stam will report to Joseph C. Muscari, Chairman and Chief Executive of Minerals Technologies. The business segment had annual revenues of \$180.1 million in 2015.

"Tom Stam has extensive experience in the construction industry, including intimate knowledge of the worldwide markets in which the business segment operates," said Mr. Muscari. "We are very pleased that he will be taking on this new role in which he will drive growth, especially by taking advantage of the environmental opportunities in China."

Mr. Stam joined the company in 1989 as a regional sales manager. He left what was then American Colloid Company in 1995, but returned as Director, Business Development, in 2002, after serving seven years in project management for a subsidiary of Waste Management. In 2005, he was promoted to Group Manager, North America, Building Materials, Construction Technologies. He became Vice President, Building Materials, Construction Technologies, in 2011, and he assumed the position of Senior Vice President, Building Materials and Environmental Products for the business unit in February 2016.

Mr. Stam holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Geology from Eastern Illinois University.
