

## Minerals Technologies Elects Three New Officers

The company elected Gary L. Castagna, senior vice president and managing director, Performance Materials; Patrick E. Monagle, who has been chief operating officer (COO) and senior vice president and managing director of Paper PCC, will continue as COO for the Paper PCC, Performance Minerals and Refractories business units.

Mr. Carpenter joined CETCO in 1992 and has held a number of management positions for both the Building Materials and Lining Technologies business groups. He was promoted to president of CETCO in January 2012.

Mr. Johnson joined CETCO Oilfield Services Company in 1997 as a group manager. He was promoted to division manager in 1999, named vice president of CETCO Oilfield Services Company in 2001, and to president of CETCO Oilfield Services in 2004. In 2010, he was named a vice president of AMCOL. Before joining CETCO, Mr. Johnson was president and part owner of Gulf States Environmental.

Mr. Monagle joined Minerals Technologies in 2003 as director, Global Marketing, Paper PCC. He was named vice president, North America, Paper PCC, in 2004, and in 2006, was appointed vice president, the Americas, Paper PCC.
